Consider the difference between these two statements: "I want to avoid sin because sin is bad" and "Because I'm united with Jesus, I want to avoid sin." Which sentence has the right view of the gospel? Explain.

Can remembering your union with Jesus and that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit also teach you to avoid nonsexual sins? If so, how?

Why is reminding one another about the truths of the gospel a fundamental part of the Christian community?
