What are examples of the mistaken belief that single Christians are at a disadvantage?

Why is it important to remember that both the married and singles do well before the Lord (v. 38).

The main idea of this passage of scripture was: "Married couples and singles should aim to live in ways pleasing to God and work for His kingdom, yet singles have a special opportunity to serve God and avoid many earthly difficulties." How have you seen this truth lived out?
