#### **Small Group Questions:**

Thinking about this week's teaching, was there a particular point, verse or comment that caught your attention, challenged you, or raised a question?

What are some ways you've seen churches or ministries try to manufacture revival? How is that different from what we see happen in Ephesus?

Upon hearing the news about Jesus, the disciples of John are saved, baptized, and filled with the Holy Spirit. What is the Holy Spirit's role in salvation? Why is water baptism important and what does it represent?

Paul discipled people for two years in the hall of Tyrannus. What was the impact of that discipleship? What does this teach us about the importance of intentionally making room for people wrestling with faith in Jesus? What does this teach us about the importance of consistency with our community groups?

The seven sons of Sceva try to use the name of Jesus and get severely humbled. What are ways our culture undermines the name of Jesus? What are ways we take for granted the power of the name of Jesus?

Someone look up the definition of the word, extol. Someone look up the definition of the word, fear. How should we apply both of those words to the name of Jesus? What does it look like for you, personally, to extoll and fear the name of the Lord?
