We reject the gospel by believing distorted claims.

We reject the gospel by ignoring objective facts.

We reject the gospel by delaying our appropriate response.

Small Group Questions:

Thinking about this week's teaching, was there a particular point, verse or comment that caught your attention, challenged you, or raised a question?

Paul has continuously had to defend himself against distorted claims about him and his ministry. What are some of the claims of our culture against the church?

Paul's religious and civil records are impeccable. What does this teach us about how important our words and behavior are as followers of Jesus?

Paul consistently comes back to the resurrection as part of his defense. Why did he do that? Why is that important for us today?

When Paul presents the gospel to Felix and Drusilla, he doesn't just present information. He speaks to the issues of their brokenness. How do we do that same thing with the people in our lives who need to hear about Jesus?

Felix delays responding to the gospel. This is such a common mentality in our culture. How should we present the gospel patiently, but with the urgency it deserves?
